**HOWDY Fellow GFWBA Members,** 

Let me begin by informing all of you that we were forced to postpone Municipal Awards Night because our speaker Beth Van Dyne had to cancel too late to engage another speaker. Evidently, the GOP retreat to prepare for the November election cycle was scheduled for the same weekend and she cannot miss it. We plan to rebook for mid-November and will let you know as soon as it is scheduled.

The Winter TAB meetings were held in Austin at a new venue on April 5th-7th. GFWBA was well represented this year with > 14 members attending. We are also playing a significant role in leadership with Don Allen serving as VP -Secretary, Heather Laminack as Chair of PWB, Bill Bettis as the Area 2 Vice President, Rod Vochatzer as Chair of Associates Council, James Rodriguez leadership on the new Energy codes, John Montgomery's role with Hammer & Nails and GFWBA participation on the various councils. Some of the highlights include ...

- Lt Governor Dan Patrick spoke to us about the significance of housing affordability on the Texas economy. He supports our industry and is aware of the impact of rising costs and property taxes. He stated that he plans to support further reductions in property taxes.
- The PWB "Wine Pull" was both fun and a real money-maker that will go towards a scholarship fund for women in the building industry.
- GFWBA received recognition for exceeding our HomePac goal ... 167%!
- Hammer & Nails held real-time discussions on TAB support of specific politicians running for office
- Code discussions including concerns raised by various local chapters. We learned that cities do NOT have to accept a code update in its entirety! (e.g. exterior shut-off for electrical power).

Regarding local elections, we have reached out to several victors with endorsements and checks to solidify relationships as we move forward. We have also provided support to some run-off candidates. A questionnaire was also sent to candidates to determine their positions on the building industry. Several responses were received that impacted our support. During the last month, we have met with ...

- Tim O'Hare candidate for Tarrant County Judge
- Chris Boedeker candidate for Johnson County Judge
- Rep Brian Harrison U.S. District 10

Gov't Affairs also met with Lauren Prieur, Assistant Director of TPW. She presented the city's road infrastructure improvement plans as well as Proposition: \$360,218,300 A for Street and Mobility Infrastructure improvements. GFWBA has decided to endorse this Proposition A as it is critical for future residential developments.




