

HOWDY Fellow GFWBA Members,

2022 is turning out to be an eventful year thus far.

The International Builders Show was held in Orlando Florida in mid-May. Although not as big as the last Vegas show, there was still a good turn out of Vendors along with a lot of informative seminars and meetings to attend. Plus, with fewer attendees, you could actually see everything. Some of the newest trends I observed are ...

- Color is back ... green and black are favorites
- White kitchens are out
- "wellness" features are top consideration ... induction vs gas cooktops with good ventilation, lots of live plants in spaces, spa baths, natural lighting, etc
- Open-concept is evolving to bring back some separation between kitchens and living
- "back kitchens" for with ovens, sinks, dishwashers for "real" work vs "front" kitchens for show & entertaining
- New appliance lines that are more affordable ... AND ... available.

The primary elections are over. Several of the candidates we supported were successful. In other cases, we now have the opportunity to develop new relationships with the winning candidates.

We are excited to announce that we have hired a new staff member for the Business Development position that will be responsible for promoting GFWBA and expanding our membership. Kaitlin Smith will be starting April 11th and attending many meetings and events thereafter. Please welcome her when you meet her.

The GFWBA "brand" for our member signs has been finalized and will be available later this month in both sticker and electronic format. We are encouraging all members to apply this brand on their yard signs and other forms of advertisements so that the public recognizes us as an association of Building Professionals.

In parallel, we will be rolling out a "beta test site" for the Find-A-Builder program by early April. You will receive an email from Kimberly with the link to this preview website. Please try it out and provide your comments. To my knowledge, this is the first time a Builders' Association will be generating leads for its members. We need your help to make it as useful as we can. Our goal is to launch the real website sometime in May 2022.

In terms of the predicting the future of residential construction as we go thru 2022-23, we have learned a lot from our annual Economic Forecast as well as two education lunch seminars on supply chain. My "readers-digest" take-away from these sessions was ...

- Residential construction is booming in Texas and will continue to do so as long as ...
- o The influx of people from states like California continues
- o The interest rates stay below 4.5%
- There is an existing and increasing shortage of housing, lots, and rental properties in our area
- Supply chain issues are not going away any time soon
- Expect 20-25% increase in the cost of goods for every \$1 that diesel increases since so much of our supplies depend on the trucking industry

There is another informative education lunch on March 23rd entitled "Wait, I already paid for that and lost my deposits during supply shortage". If there is something that you a particularly interested in learning about, let us know and we will try to schedule it.


