The Supreme Court of Texas ruled in favor of Builder Recovery Services, LLC



On Friday, May 20, 2022 The Supreme Court of Texas ruled in favor of Builder Recovery Services, LLC (GFWBA member) and remanded the case back to the Appeals Court for conclusion. BRS and Garabedian Properties received support from across the state with contributions and amicus briefs from the Greater Fort Worth Builders Association, Dallas Builders Association, Austin Builders Association, Houston Builders Association, Big Country Builders Association, and the Texas Association of Builders. This teamwork and cooperation is a testament to the power of the builder community within the Builders

Association. Alone we are one voice in the wild, together we are 10,000 strong fighting to protect the home building industry and keep housing as affordable as possible.

How to Become a Spike

(bring in 6 new members to become a Spike)

Spike Points or Credits represent each new member brought in
To become a Spike, you must earn at least six credits. The best way to earn credits is to recruit a new
member to the Federation. You can also earn credits for renewals and recruiting new NAHB Council
members. You can earn:

- 1 credit for each new builder or associate member you recruit
- 1 credit on the first anniversary of each new member you recruited
- ½ of a credit for each anniversary that follows for each of those members
 - ½ of a credit for recruiting council members to their local association

Once you accrue 6 Spike credits, you officially become a Spike and a member of the Spike Club — a network of Spikes across the nation focused on the growth their associations. As you continue to accumulate credits, your status rises within the Spike Club.
